



The Ray Tate Student Athlete Scholarship

The Scholarship Fund will be awarded annually to recognize a currently enrolled, Steward Boy and Girl Senior who best exemplifies the qualities of an exemplary student-athlete. The award is presented at the fall Ray Tate Golf Tournament. These qualities include:

- ✓ Exhibits excellent character and espouses the value of responsible citizenship consistent with the mission, values and philosophy of The Steward School
- ✓ Possesses a strong work ethic, high values, commitment and a positive, team-oriented attitude
- ✓ Demonstrates meaningful extracurricular involvement
- ✓ Consistently shows respect for teachers, coaches, adults, self and others

Specific eligibility and criteria includes:

1. This is a competitive scholarship, to be awarded by application, with a decision being made by the Ray Tate Student Athlete Scholarship selection committee. Preference should go to students who meets the above requirements and has a true need of financial assistance.
2. The committee will be comprised of: Bruce Secrest, Athletic Director, Carol Moore, Upper School Division Director, Spartan Club Board President and Vice President, B. Lee Healey, Assistant to the Upper School Division Director, and Gardner A. Mundy, Dean of Upper School Students.
3. The students must be a current student-athlete who is also involved in meaningful extra curricula activities, including an outside cause.
4. The students must be in good academic standing by maintaining at least a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
5. The scholarship award is \$1,000 towards each recipient's Steward Tuition account or in the event that multiple recipients of the same gender are selected, the amount of the award will be divided equally amongst those gender recipients.
6. The Assistant to the Upper School Division Director will handle the ordering of the award plaques. The finance department will handle the credit of the award to each recipient's tuition account.
